Canadian First World War Internment Recognition Fund Awards the Edmonton Public School District No. 7 with an Education Grant. May 17, 2011 – Edmonton, Alberta

On Tuesday, May 17th, Andrew Hladyshevsky, Q.C., Interim Chair of CFWWIRF signed a contribution agreement with Dana Antaya-Moore of Edmonton Public School District No. 7. Witnessing this document was Andrew Antoniuk representing the Descendants of Ukrainian Canadian Internment Victims Association. (DUCIVA)

This student resource book grant was initiated by the members of DUCIVA to foster an understanding of the impact the internment had on Ukrainian families after they were classified as enemy aliens. This project will give students and teachers a comprehensive understanding of the internment of Ukrainians and other Eastern Europeans during Canada's national internment operations of 1914 to 1920. It is expected to be available in the Edmonton Public School District No. 7 by September of this year.
