"O Holy Light" represents a time of year when we gather together in celebration. At Christmas a candle symbolizing the Star of Bethlehem is lit and placed in a Kolach (Christmas Bread). Like the star, a single candle can light our way. When many candles are lit, darkness is removed and the warmth of the season glows in our hearts.

- ▶ Bids are strictly confidential and will be reviewed by authorized personnel only and **the current high bid will be updated regularly on the UCC website**
