Drs. Luba and Ireneus Zuk were born in Western Ukraine and came to Canada in the third wave of Ukrainian emigration. They both are graduates of McGill University and the Conservatoire de musique de Québec (Montreal) as well as the Mozarteum (Salzburg) and the University of Alberta Banff School of Fine Arts.

Luba obtained her Doctorate in Musicology from the Ukrainian Free University (Munich) while Ireneus has further studied at the Royal College of Music (London), the Julliard School of Music (New York) and earned a Doctorate from the Peabody Conservatory of John Hopkins University (Baltimore).

Luba is presently a professor in the School of Music, McGill University, while Ireneus is a professor at Queen's university.

Luba and Ireneus have performed as soloists and as a piano duo. It is in this latter capacity that they are being hosted by the Tarnawecky Distinguished Lecture Series at the Centre for Ukrainian Canadian Studies (University of Manitoba). Together they have performed and recorded music by Ukrainian and Canadian composers across the world including Ukraine and most of Europe, as well as throughout Canada, the USA and China. In addition they have served on international music juries and adjudicated at many Canadian music festivals.

The Zuk Piano Duo has been awarded many medals over the years including the prestigious award "Merited Artist of Ukraine" (1999) and the "Shevchenko Medal" (2007) by the Ukrainian Canadian Congress.
