### **NATIONAL HOLODOMOR AWARENESS COMMITTEE (NHAC)**

#### **DRAFT TERMS OF REFERENCE**

1. The goal of NHAC is to share the story of the Holodomor with the broadest spectrum of Canadian society possible - Ukrainians and non-Ukrainians alike.
2. NHAC will coordinate the development and delivery of cohesive and creative national messaging including the lessons and values of truth, tolerance, and respect for human dignity and rights.
3. NHAC will support and include representation from UCC provincial and local Holodomor awareness committees, as well as organizations and individuals that work toward raising awareness in Canada of the Holodomor.
4. NHAC will work closely with survivors of the Holodomor and their descendants to ensure the story of the Holodomor is told accurately, respectfully and inclusively, and that the flame of remembrance will burn brightly for generations to come.
5. NHAC will work closely with the UCC Holodomor Education Committee, Ukrainian Canadian Research and Documentation Centre, Holodomor Research and Education Consortium and Holodomor National Awareness Tour to promote awareness.
6. NHAC will work closely with the Ukrainian World Congress International Holodomor Awareness Committee and other national Holodomor awareness committees to develop a coordinated global approach to awareness raising initiatives.
7. NHAC will work with other ethnocultural communities on sharing the story of the Holodomor.
8. NHAC will encourage all forms of communication and projects to disseminate the messages.
